

- 1. Remove the toolbox and mounting bracket; drill out the bracket holes to 25/32".
- 2. Remove the two plastic plugs from the front bolster.
- 3. Open the grill and insert the threaded flange plugs from the inside.
- 4. Bolt the support bracket to the flange plugs with two 3/4" x 2" bolts and lock washers. **Do not tighten** at this time.
- 5. Bolt the arms to the sides of the tractor with two 3/4" x 2" bolts, lock washers and nuts; and to the support bracket with two 5/8" x 2" bolts, lock washers and nuts. **Do not tighten at this time.**Note: Reattach the toolbox on the left side.
- 6. Mount the weight box to the arms with eight 1/2" x 1-1/2" bolts and flange nuts. **Note:** Position the weight box so the grill will clear the top of the weight box.
- 7. Tighten all bolts securely.




